The Board has decided the New Year is time to decide what improvements are most easily achieved within a limited budget and and which provide members with the greatest benefits.

Priority 1 is to convert the Gaming Room and make provision for it to become a smoking area. Louvres will replace windows, air extraction plant will be installed and the whole area refurbished.


